Every year, the Davis High Drama Program performs a play which incorporates K-8 students from the community. Many past and present FOP students have participated and enjoyed the experience. This year's show is called *That's Our Folks!* and is a celebration of students and their cultures. Rehearsals are on Saturday mornings for half an hour, on January 26, February 9 and February 23, with a dress rehearsal on the morning of March 2. Each student will perform once at Davis High on March 8, 9 or 10, and once at the Gallo Center on March 15. There is no cost to participate, other than an optional t-shirt purchase. Families who can seriously commit to being at all four mandatory rehearsals and the performance dates should go to the Davis High Little Theatre (park in the east parking lot off Rumble, by the tennis courts) on Friday, December 7, from 3:30-5:00pm for a Role Call.
